Future Expansion: If you plan to add more luminaires later, you can use a dual control or supply tap-off box to share power from the spare circuit while maintaining independent control of the new lighting group.

Safety and Best Practices Ensure the main feeder cable can handle the total anticipated load, including the spare circuit. Use the correct wire size for the circuit; for a 16A lighting circuit, 2.5mm² copper wire is standard. Label the spare circuit clearly in the distribution box for future identification. Avoid overloading the spare circuit; calculate the total wattage of lights before connecting them.
