

# Specifications of Telecommunication Optical Cables



## AI Overview

Telecommunication optical cables are designed according to international standards to ensure reliable transmission, low attenuation, and mechanical durability, with specifications varying by fiber type, application, and environmental conditions.

**Fiber Types and Applications** Optical fibers in telecommunication cables are primarily classified as single-mode (SMF) and multimode (MMF). Single-mode fibers, such as ITU-T G.652, are optimized for long-distance transmission at 1310 nm and 1550 nm with low attenuation and minimal dispersion, suitable for backbone, metro, and access networks. Multimode fibers, including OM1, OM2, OM3, OM4, and OM5, are used for shorter distances like LANs, data centers, and premises wiring, supporting LED, VCSEL, or laser sources at 850 nm, 953 nm, and 1300 nm.

**Optical and Transmission Characteristics** Key optical specifications include:

- Attenuation:** Typically measured in dB/km, with single-mode fibers achieving 0.2 dB/km at 1550 nm and multimode fibers slightly higher.
- Dispersion:** Single-mode fibers have zero dispersion near 1310 nm, while non-zero dispersion-shifted fibers (G.655) reduce nonlinear effects in DWDM systems.
- Cut-off wavelength:** Defines the minimum wavelength for single-mode operation.
- Numerical aperture and core/cladding diameters:** Standardized to ensure compatibility and efficient light propagation.

**Mechanical and Environmental Specifications** Optical cables are designed to withstand environmental and mechanical stresses:

- Tensile strength and crush resistance:** Ensures durability during installation and operation.
- Bend radius:** Minimum bend radius is specified to prevent microbending losses.
- Water-blocking and sheath materials:** Protect fibers from moisture and chemical exposure.
- Temperature range:** Cables are rated for typical service conditions over 25 years without performance degradation.
