- DIN Rail:** Standardized mounting system for modular devices.
- Enclosure:** Protects internal components from dust, moisture, and physical damage.

Typical Internal Layout

A standard single-phase DB layout includes:

- Incoming Supply:** Phase (L) and Neutral (N) connected to the main MCB.
- Main MCB / Double Pole MCB:** Acts as the primary switch for the DB.
- Outgoing MCBs:** Single-pole or double-pole breakers for individual circuits.
- RCCB:** Installed alongside MCBs for leakage protection.
- Busbars:** Phase busbar connected to MCBs; neutral and earth bars connected to respective terminals.
- SPD:** Connected to protect sensitive equipment from surges.
- Wiring and Cable Entries:** Organized to maintain clear access and phase balance.
