The NEC 110.26 specifies minimum clearances: Front clearance: At least 3 feet (36 inches) to allow doors to open 90 degrees and safe access. Side clearance: Minimum 30 inches or the width of the equipment, whichever is greater. Height clearance: Minimum 6.5 feet or the height of the equipment, whichever is greater. Dedicated electrical rooms should never be used for storage, and a clear path of travel must be maintained for emergency egress. Doors should accommodate the largest equipment being moved in or out, with a minimum width of 36–48 inches depending on the design. Wiring and Safety Specifications Power must be turned off during installation. Use high-temperature resistant copper wires with cross-sectional areas suitable for the load. Ensure neat cable management, proper insulation, and clear labeling of circuits. All cable inlets and cover joints should be sealed to prevent dust or moisture ingress. Grounding and Protection The metal enclosure, electrical board, and appliance casings must be properly grounded. The protective neutral wire should be securely connected through a terminal board.
