The box should be installed in a dry, ventilated, and accessible area, typically 1.5–1.8 meters above ground for ease of operation and inspection.

Internal Components and Layout A main distribution box typically includes:

- Busbars:** Copper or aluminum conductors distributing power to branch circuits.
- Protective devices:** MCBs, RCDs, RCBOs, fuses, surge protective devices, and isolators for each circuit.
- Neutral and earth bars:** Properly connected to ensure grounding and safety.
- DIN rails and cable entries:** Facilitate neat wiring and future expansion. The internal layout should allow adequate heat dissipation, clear separation of live and neutral conductors, and sufficient space for wiring and future upgrades.

Electrical and Wiring Requirements

- Rated current and short-circuit capacity:** Must match the actual load and available fault current.
- Wiring:** Use high-temperature resistant copper conductors with cross-sectional area suitable for load; ensure proper insulation and secure connections.
- Grounding:** Metal enclosures, electrical boards, and appliances must be reliably grounded; protective neutral wires should be conne...
