

Standard for Temporary Electrical Distribution Boxes at Zambian Construction Sites

- Load Capacity and Circuit Protection** Distribution boxes should be sized to handle the maximum anticipated load, including lighting, power tools, and welding equipment. Circuit breakers or fuses must be installed to protect against overloads and short circuits, in accordance with DZS 418-1:2024.
- Grounding and Earthing** Proper earthing of the distribution box is required to prevent electric shock hazards. All metallic parts must be bonded to the site's grounding system.
- Installation and Location** Boxes should be installed on stable, elevated platforms to avoid water ingress and mechanical damage. Placement must allow safe access for workers while minimizing exposure to hazards.
- Maintenance and Safety** Regular inspection and maintenance are required to ensure the boxes remain in good working order. Safety barriers and warning signs should be used to restrict access to the boxes.
