Save the configuration: `endwrite memory` Setting a Global Power Limit If multiple high-power devices are connected, you can set a global per-port maximum to prevent exceeding the switch's total PoE budget. This ensures fair distribution and avoids random device resets. On Cisco Catalyst switches, the command is: `power inline port max` This sets the maximum power a port can draw, helping manage the overall power budget. Managing Power Priorities When the switch's total PoE budget is nearly exhausted, you can assign priority levels to ports. High-priority ports continue receiving power while lower-priority ports may be temporarily disabled if the budget is exceeded. This is useful for critical devices like IP phones or security cameras. Monitoring and Troubleshooting Use `show power inline` to monitor consumption and detect faults. Ensure the total power demand of all connected devices plus overhead does not exceed the switch's PSU capacity. Add 25–30% overhead for cable loss an...
