- Bend Radius:** Respect the minimum bend radius of each cable to prevent insulation damage, especially at tray entries and exits.
- Segregation:** Separate cables by voltage, function, or signal type to minimize interference and simplify maintenance.
- Securing and Organizing** Use cable ties, straps, or clamps to secure cables at regular intervals, typically every 300–600 mm for thin cables. Leave slack for thermal expansion, movement, or future adjustments.
- Label** Label cables clearly for identification and troubleshooting, and maintain a wiring map for reference.
- Safety and Compliance** Ensure grounding and bonding of metal trays to maintain electrical safety. Follow NEC/IEC standards for ampacity derating, fire safety, and cable handling. Perform a final inspection to check for loose clamps, misalignment, or overfilled sections.
- Maintenance** Regularly inspect trays for corrosion, loose ties, or damaged cables to extend system life and maintain reliability.
