The enclosure protects the electrical components from water, dust, and damage. When choosing one, check the IP or NEMA rating. A higher rating means better protection — especially useful for outdoor or industrial use. Single Phase Distribution Box generally consists of Double Pole MCBs, Single Pole MCBs, and RCCBs. three phase lines a, B and C (generally yellow, green and red), one zero line (light blue) and one ground line (yellow with green stripes).
