Fusion Splicing Fusion splicing is the preferred method for three-end splicing due to its low insertion loss (0.01–0.03 dB) and high reliability . The process involves: Stripping and cleaning the fiber ends. Precisely aligning the three fibers using a fusion splicer capable of multi-fiber alignment or sequential splicing. Using an electric arc to fuse the glass ends together, creating a continuous optical path. Protecting the splice with a heat-shrink sleeve or splice closure to prevent mechanical stress and environmental damage. Fusion splicing ensures a permanent, stable connection suitable for backbone networks and high-speed deployments . 2. Mechanical Splicing Mechanical splicing can also be used for three-end connections, especially for temporary setups or emergency repairs . This method uses: A mechanical alignment device to hold the fibers in precise contact. Index-matching gel to reduce light loss and back reflection. A protective housing to secure the splice. Mechanical splicing is easier to perform in the field but typically has higher insertion loss (0.1–0.3 dB) and is less durable than fusion splicing. Protection and Best Practices Splice Closures: Use a splice closure designed for multi-fiber splicing to protect the joint from moisture, dust, and mechanical stress . Cable Management: Ensure fibers are properly routed and secured to prevent bending or tension that could degrade performance. Testing...
