The selection of a distribution box depends on the specific zone and the type of flammable material present, such as IIA, IIB, or IIC gas groups.

Material and Construction

- Stainless Steel or Coated Aluminum:** Preferred for aggressive chemical environments and outdoor installations.
- Polymer Housings:** Suitable for certain zones but must meet certified standards.

Ingress Protection: IP69K-rated joints, cable glands, and seals ensure protection against water and dust ingress, especially in washdown or outdoor conditions.
