They are classified according to NEMA standards: Class 1: For NEMA 12B and 12C trays, with 1 1/8" side rail flanges and 4-hole splice plates. Class 2: For NEMA 20A, 20B, and 20C trays, with 2" side rail flanges and 4-hole splice plates. Class 3: For trays exceeding 20C, with 2 3/8" side rail flanges and 8-hole splice plates. Height and width of elbows match the corresponding tray sections, typically ranging from 50 mm to 300 mm in width and 50 mm to 120 mm in height, depending on the system design. Standards and Compliance Elbows must comply with relevant standards to ensure safety and performance: ANSI/NFPA 70 – National Electrical Code, ASTM A123, A653, A1011, A1008, B633 – Steel and coating specifications, NEMA VE 1 & VE 2 – M...
