

What are the protection conditions for optical fiber cables

LSZH (Low Smoke Zero Halogen) sheathed cables are more sensitive to mechanical stress and temperature, requiring careful handling.

Personal Safety and Handling Fiber optic work involves risks from glass shards and laser exposure: Wear safety glasses with side shields to protect eyes from fiber shards. Use gloves when handling epoxy or fiber fragments to prevent skin contact. Keep the work area clean to control hazardous glass fragments. Use tweezers to collect cleaved fiber pieces and dispose of them safely. Avoid direct eye exposure to laser light; use appropriate filters and diffused light precautions.
