Splicing to Pigtails The next step involves splicing the incoming fiber to pigtails, which are short fiber cables with connectors on one end . This can be done using fusion splicing, which permanently joins the fibers, or mechanical splicing, which aligns them precisely without melting. The pigtails then serve as the interface between the main fiber line and the customer's equipment, allowing for a stable, high-quality connection .

Connection to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT) After splicing, the fiber is routed from the junction box to the Optical Network Terminal (ONT), which may be installed inside or just outside the building . The ONT converts the light signals from the fiber into electrical signals that can be used by routers or gateways to provide internet, video, and voice services . The ONT is typically connected to a Wi-Fi gateway or router via an Ethernet cable, enabling network distribution throughout the home or office .

Additional Functions The junction box also acts as a demarcation point between the service provider's network and the customer's internal wiring, allowing technicians to troubleshoot or upgrade the network without entering the building
