Components and Circuit A typical protective relay system includes: Current or voltage transformers to sense electrical quantities. Relay coil that responds to abnormal conditions. Circuit breaker trip coil that disconnects the faulty section. Contacts (normally open or normally closed) that complete the tripping circ...
