These binders combine water-blocking functionality with low shrinkage and high tensile strength, allowing high-speed binding on SZ-stranded optical fibers without compromising performance . Nonwoven tapes and PET film-laminated tapes are also used in fiber optic cables to provide additional mechanical stability, smooth production handling, and protection against electromagnetic interference (EMI) in certain applications. These tapes are particularly useful in jelly-free or loose tube cables and dynamic or safety-critical cables . Late Binding Fiber Patch Cables Late binding refers to fiber patch cables that are terminated with connectors at both ends after the main cable installation. These cables are used in data centers for rack-to-rack or top-of-rack connections, offering high-density connectors and off-the-shelf lengths. Late binding cables simplify upgrades, increase fiber density per rack unit, and reduce installation time while maintaining high reliability .
