- UV and corrosion resistance:** PE sheath protects against sunlight, radiation, and environmental degradation.

Applications

GYFTY cables are ideal for aerial, duct, and conduit installations in environments where metallic components are unsuitable, such as:

- Power transmission corridors
- High-voltage or lightning-prone areas
- Electromagnetic interference (EMI) sensitive zones
- Telecommunications networks, data centers, and utility applications

While generally not recommended for direct burial, GYFTY cables can be installed in HDPE conduits for underground applications. They support both singlemode and multimo...
