Nature of Electrical Charge in Fiber Optics Fiber optic cables transmit light signals, not electricity, so the core optical fibers do not carry an electrical charge under normal operation . However, the connector end-faces and ferrules can develop static charges, also known as triboelectric charges, when materials rub against each other or when dust particles contact the surface .
