- Phase Lines (A, B, C):** Carry the main current in a three-phase system, often color-coded for safety.
- Neutral Line:** Provides a return path for unbalanced loads, stabilizing the system.
- Ground Wire:** Ensures safety by directing fault currents to the earth.
- Circuit Breaker:** Protects the distribution box and connected loads from overcurrent.
- Dual Power Switch (if applicable):** Automatically switches to a backup supply if the main supply fails, ensuring uninterrupted power.
