For ribbon cables, a UV-curable resin is used to hold multiple fibers together.

Strength and Protective Components Fiber optic cables include strength members and protective layers to ensure durability and longevity. Common materials include: Aramid yarn (Kevlar) for tensile strength FRP rods or steel wires for structural support HDPE or LSZH jackets for outer protection against moisture, chemicals, and abrasion Water-blocking gels or tapes to prevent moisture ingress Metallic components in some cables for grounding or chemical insulation
