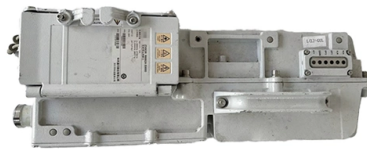


What should be used to plug holes in electrical distribution boxes
