Direct Point-to-Point (P2P) Connection If your network does not require secondary splitting, a direct fiber connection from the Optical Line Terminal (OLT) to the Optical Network Unit (ONU) or ONT at the subscriber's location can be used. This eliminates the need for an FDB entirely, as the fiber runs directly to the end user.

Using a Fiber Access Terminal (FAT) A FAT can provide fiber access to end users and protect fiber connections. It can be installed on walls, poles, or hallways and can serve as a termination point for the fiber, effectively replacing the FDB in smaller or simpler installations.

Fiber Distribution Hub (FDH) In larger networks, an FDH can distribute the main fiber to various branches and integrate optical splitters. If an FDB is unavailable, the FDH can sometimes serve as the central distribution point, especially in outdoor or multi-dwelling unit (MDU) scenarios.

Installation Considerations

Plan the Pathway Carefully: Ensure the fiber route is as short and straight as possible to minimize signal loss and avoid bends that could damage the fiber.

Protect the Fiber: Use low-voltage conduit or protective tubing in high-traffic areas to prevent physical damage.
