2. Modular Railway Cabinets Custom-made modular cabinets are widely used along tracks, in tunnels, and at stations. These enclosures manage power for signaling, trackside equipment, barrier controls, lighting, and traffic control systems. They are designed to be robust, vandal-proof, and sometimes suction-proof for tunnel installations. Materials include thermoplastics like polycarbonate or epoxy-coated stainless steel for durability .
3. Outdoor and Safety-Critical Enclosures Railway distribution boxes must protect safety-critical systems such as signaling lights and level crossings. These enclosures are weather...
