They feature reinforced cable entries, drainage systems, heaters for cold climates, and lockable doors to protect fibers from environmental hazards like rain, dust, and extreme temperatures.

Each unit functions as a standalone distribution frame, retaining the characteristics of small and medium-sized ODFs while optimizing space utilization. They are commonly used in early large-capacity fiber networks.
