The central box protects delicate fibers, organizes splices, and provides strain relief and bend-radius control. Placement is chosen to balance accessibility for technicians, protection from environmental hazards, and efficient routing of fiber cables. Indoor boxes are typically wall-mounted or rack-mounted, while outdoor boxes are installed in secure cabinets or poles.
