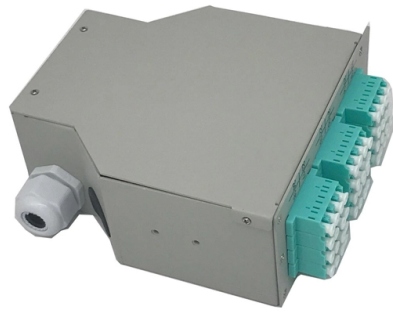


Where should the router's fiber optic cable be plugged in
