Test Signal Strength : Use a power meter or OTDR to measure signal loss. When issues like signal loss, slow speeds, or intermittent connectivity arise, systematic troubleshooting is key. This inexpensive tool that should be found in virtually every fiber technician's tool bag uses a bright laser beam of light (typically red) that can be easily seen by the human eye, unlike the invisible infrared light used by. The simplest troubleshooting tool is the Visual Fault Locator, or VFL. For prevention, install armored or industrial fiber optic cables in. When a fiber is bent past its rated bend radius, light leaks from the core and attenuation rises; this loss is a function of bend radius, number of bends and signal wavelength.
