A junction box is a protective enclosure that safely houses electrical connections, preventing hazards and allowing future maintenance. Purpose of a Junction Box A junction box is used to contain and protect electrical splices or connections in a wiring system, whether for outlets, switches, or other devices. It prevents electrical faults, sparks, and potential fire hazards while keeping wires organized and accessible for inspection or repair. Junction boxes can be made of metal or plastic, with metal boxes often used where conduit or mechanical durability is required, and plastic boxes common in residential non-metallic cable systems. Selecting the Right Box Choosing the correct junction box is critical. Boxes are sized according to the number and gauge of conductors they will contain, as overcrowding can lead to heat buildup and fire hazards. The National Electrical Code provides guidelines for box volume based on wire size (AWG) and number of conductors. For example, two cables with three 14-AWG conductors each require a minimum box volume of 13 cubic inches. Boxes are also categorized as new-work (for open framing) or old-work/remodel (for finished walls or ceilings).

Wiring Procedure

Safety First: Turn off the circuit breaker and verify zero voltage with a non-contact tester.

Prepare Wires: Strip the outer sheathing and insulation from individual conductors without nicking the copper strands. Leave 6–8 inches of wire inside the box for splicing.

Secure Cables: Use approved clamps or connectors to prevent cables from being pulled out and to protect the sheathing.

Grounding: Connect all bare or green grounding wires together, and attach a grounding pigtail to the metal box if applicable.

Neutral Connections: Splice all white (neutral) wires together using pigtails to maintain continuity.

Hot Connections: Connect all black (hot) wires, ensuring proper color coding to avoid faults.

Organize and Cover: Carefully fold wire bundles inside the box and close it with an accessible cover.
