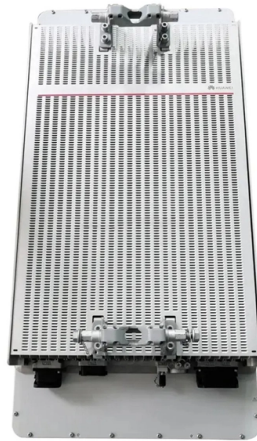

Material Preparation: Gather all required breakers, wires, wiring ties, and ensure they meet design specifications ().

Placement and Arrangement: Install the distribution box in a dry, accessible location, typically around 1.5 meters above the floor. Arrange breakers from left to right, reserving space for future expansion ().

Wire Selection and Color Coding:

- Phase wires:** A – yellow, B – green, C – red
- Neutral wire:** blue
- Ground wire:** green/yellow striped

Wire gauge depends on load: 2.5mm² for lighting and sockets, 4mm² for high-power circuits like air conditioning ().

Connections: Connect the incoming supply to the main MCB. Branch circuits are connected to individual MCBs. RCCBs are connected in series with branch circuits for leakage protection (). Use parallel connections where necessary to simplify wiring ().

Wiring Direction and Binding: Main circuit wiring generally enters from the left; outgoing circuits exit from the right. Secure wires wit...
