 - Ground Wire:** Green or green-yellow wire connects to the grounding terminal.
- Install the Meter:** Place the meter into the socket following manufacturer instructions.
- Connect Load Wires:** From the meter to the main distribution panel, ensuring each branch circuit is connected to the appropriate breaker.
- Double-Pole Breakers for 240V Appliances:** Connect across both phases for high-power devices.
- Single-Pole Breakers for Lighting and Outlets:** Typically rated 15–20 amps.
- Bonding and Grounding:** Neutral and ground bars are bonded only in the main panel; subpanels must isolate these to prevent circulating currents.

Wiring for Three-Phase (380V) Systems

- Each phase (L1, L2, L3) connects to the meter's incoming terminals. Neutral and ground connections follow the same principles as single-phase systems.
- Branch breakers are selected based on load requirements for each phase.
